- Why Voiance? Because it is already recognized by state Purchasing under NASPO ValuePoint Master Service Agreement 90-000-18-00003AG.
- What does this mean? If a primary PSAP with ANGEN connectivity decides that they want the Board to pay for Voiance Language Translation Services as an on-network transfer/feature, complete this survey. Each individual PSAP will need to complete separate surveys,


