CHAPTER 585-X-1

LEGAL AUTHORITY

**585-X-1-.01**      **Statutory Authority.** The Statutory authority for the establishment of the Alabama 9-1-1 Board which shall be responsible for establishing a statewide 9-1-1 charge, to administer the 9-1-1 Fund and monthly 9-1-1 charge, to distribute revenue in the 9-1-1 Fund, ~~and to develop and publish a state-9-1-1 plan Annual Report, and to administer the deployment and operation of a statewide 911 voice and data system~~ is as found at in Section 11-98-4.1, Code of Ala. 1975.
