Minutes of 1/16/2019

Prior notice of this regularly scheduled meeting of the Alabama 9-1-1 Board was given in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. The minutes were recorded by Mrs. Dana Grubbs, Program Coordinator.

A quorum was established. Mr. Alan Campbell, Vice Chair of the Board, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Campbell called for the unanimous consent for the approval of the agenda. There were no objections and the adoption of the agenda was so ordered.

Mr. Campbell then called for the unanimous consent for the approval of the minutes from the November 14, 2018 Board meeting. There were no objections and the adoption of the minutes was so ordered.

Mr. Campbell continued by asking for guest introductions from the audience. It is noted that John Nettles entered the meeting at 10:06 a.m.

ANGEN Report:

Mr. Caleb Branch, Market Manager for INdigital, began with a progress report of the current activities through the different phases of the project including ESInet deployment, network buildout, and circuit conversion. Mr. Branch offered a detailed explanation of each of the four phases of the project and discussed the current activity, progress, and barriers for each phase.

Mr. Branch also reported that Texty is now active in Winston County and was used this past weekend to process a call.

Mr. Branch also reported on upcoming PSAP Outreach with a review of the Regional AL911.net User Training dates:

- i. January 29 Livingston
- ii. January 30 Enterprise
- iii. January 31 Mobile

He encouraged participation by PSAPs for learning the features and functions of ANGEN.

Mr. Branch concluded his report with a review of graphs indicating call counts, trouble ticket comparisons, project phase summaries, and an ANGEN status map.

Legal Report:

Mr. Jim Sasser, General Counsel to the Board, had no report.

Financial Report:

Mr. Ron Cooley, the Board's Financial Analyst, provided the Board with the monthly interim financial statements for the month and three months ending December 31, 2018. Mr. Cooley presented the Board with a series of financial statements that included a summary of all accounts as well as individual accounts.

Mrs. Chris Heger made a motion to accept the financial statements; seconded by Mr. Robert Smith. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.

Director's Report:

Mrs. Leah Missildine began the Director's report with a review of the Examiner's Legal Compliance audit report that was filed on December 28, 2018. Mrs. Missildine reported there are five current findings and eight unresolved findings. Mrs. Missildine also reported that during the exit interview with the Examiner's office there were several findings that the Board sought the opportunity to have those findings reviewed; however, the Examiner's office stood behind their findings. Mrs. Missildine also reiterated to the Board that due to the initial audit report being released after the current audit period had ended, these unresolved findings were not unexpected. Mrs. Missildine discussed the five current findings individually and the changes that have been implemented to avoid them moving forward.



There was a discussion from the Board regarding previous findings, inconsistencies in the findings from the Examiner's, and the perceived lack of oversight of the Examiner's process.

Mrs. Missildine continued her report with an update on the ECD Annual Reporting required by the Examiner's Office. These annual reports are due November 30 of each year. She reported that the staff worked with the Examiner's Office to rework the form and improve it for the Districts. She also reported that 9 ECDs did not report, one of those being dissolved, and shared this was the best response so far for submissions.

Mrs. Missildine had nothing to report on the progress of the Federal 9-1-1 Grant Program as there has been no advancements in the release of the application.

Mr. Fred Johnson left the meeting at 10:46 a.m.

Mrs. Missildine also reported that legal services RFPs had been received in the month of December and were being reviewed. She stated she is expecting to meet with the Executive Committee and that a recommendation would be forthcoming.

Mrs. Missildine made the recommendation to the Board to extend Mr. Sasser's contract for legal services on a month-by-month basis until the next 12-month contract is executed.

Mr. Larry Fisher made the motion to extend Mr. Sasser's contract for legal services on a month-by-month basis; Mr. Tim Webb seconded. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.

Mr. Fred Johnson reentered the meeting at 10:49 a.m.

Mrs. Missildine then continued by mentioning the ECD Certifications that are due by January 31, 2019, and she extended appreciation to the 14 Districts who have already submitted and reminded all others to submit by the deadline.

Mrs. Missildine advised the Board about several Districts that have received a check from Charter Communications. She reported these checks are the result of an internal review of compliance that discovered an underpayment of 9-1-1 fees to localities prior to the existence of this Board and the collection of the 9-1-1 fee that is facilitated by the Board. Mrs. Missildine also stated that the contact information shared with the Board from the Districts listed Mrs. Jenn Shelton as the contact for Charter. She encouraged any Districts that may have been served by Charter in this time frame to contact Charter, as they could have an outstanding check.

Mrs. Missildine then reviewed current cost recovery plans and provided the Board with a summary comparison of the FYE 2018 plans as previously approved and FYE 2018 actual reimbursements. Mrs. Missildine also reported that cost recovery plans for FYE 2019 were received in November 2018 and have been reviewed. Mrs. Missildine made a recommendation to the Board to approve the cost recovery reimbursement plans as submitted for FYE 2019.

Mr. Larry Fisher questioned the amount submitted by SouthernLINC. Mrs. Missildine explained



the charges stem from an upgrade to a different network and were initially included in the FYE 2018 plan, but the work was delayed and will now be completed during FYE 2019.

Mrs. Jean Martin, SouthernLINC, spoke to the charges and the cost incurred by running two different systems and the FCC requirement to provide 9-1-1 service.

Mr. John Nettles also spoke to the increase in business costs for Pinebelt due to the FCC requirement.

Mr. Alan Campbell addressed the concerns of the Board about how cost recovery is being handled and that the Board might consider utilizing a committee review and potential rule-making.

Mrs. Missildine stated that each of these submitted plans were reviewed and falls within the FCC order currently in place.

Mr. Robert Smith made a motion to approve the FYE 2019 Cost Recovery Reimbursement plans as submitted. There was no second; therefore, there was no discussion.

Mrs. Chris Heger requested a review of the FCC Order.

Mr. Alan Campbell requested a Technical Committee meeting for review of the cost recovery plans and FCC Order. Mrs. Missildine also recommended utilizing the guidance of 9-1-1 Authority as done in previous years.

Mrs. Missildine asked Mr. Gordon Sandlin, AAND President, for any input on AANDs behalf for Legislative activity.

Mr. Sandlin reported that the Legislative Review Committee for AAND received legislative change recommendations regarding ANGEN, Annual Report from the Board, and carrier audit authority. He did report that ACCA was concerned that carriers would not like the audit authority and there was work being done to refine the language in the document.
