Minutes of 11/14/2018

Prior notice of this regularly scheduled meeting of the Alabama 9-1-1 Board was given in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act. The minutes were recorded by Mrs. Dana Grubbs, Program Coordinator.

A quorum was established. Mrs. Evelyn Causey, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Mrs. Causey called for the unanimous consent for the approval of the agenda. There were no objections and the adoption of the agenda was so ordered.

Mrs. Causey then called for the unanimous consent for the approval of the minutes from the September 19, 2018 Board meeting. There were no objections and the adoption of the minutes was so ordered.

Mrs. Causey continued by asking for guest introductions from the audience.



ANGEN Report:

Mrs. Sara Weston of 9-1-1 Authority, Consultant to the Board, presented the ANGEN Monthly Project Reviews. The reviews included a summary of deliverables, activities, travel, and action items for September and October. She shared that the Gulf Coast Conference in October went well and there was a great deal of interaction and information sharing. She also reported that we are still waiting for the release of the Federal Grant Application, work will continue towards preparing for the application.

Mrs. Weston continued her report with review of ANGEN items to come which included continued planning with INdigital, continued work on and refining the PSAP cutover strategies, continued support for legislative updates and updating the State Plan. She then turned the floor over to Mr. Caleb Branch, Market Manager for INdigital.

Mr. Branch began with a report on several milestone dates and goals that are upcoming in the ANGEN project. He also reported on current activities focused on the ANGEN 2.0 network buildout. Mr. Branch reported on upcoming PSAP Outreach with a review of the Regional AL911.net User Training dates:

He encouraged participation to learn the features and functions of ANGEN.

Mr. Branch concluded his report with a review of graphs indicating call counts, trouble ticket comparisons, project phase summaries, and an ANGEN status map.

Legal Report:

Mr. Jim Sasser, General Counsel to the Board, had no report.

Financial Report:

Mr. Ron Cooley, the Board's Financial Analyst, provided the Board with the financial reports for both FYE 2018 and one month ending October 31, 2018. Mr. Cooley presented the Board with a series of financial statements that included all accounts as well as individual accounts.

Mrs. Melissa Dove made a motion to accept the financial statements for FYE 2018; seconded by Mr. Robert Smith. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.

Mr. Robert Smith made a motion to accept the financial statements for October 2018; seconded by Mr. Alan Campbell. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.



Director's Report:

Mrs. Leah Missildine began the Director's report by presenting the Board meeting dates and staff holidays for 2019.

Mrs. Missildine continued with reporting on the Board's exit conference with the Examiner's Office. She reported on existing and new findings and that the Examiner's office has recommended the adoption of a rule to establish policies and procedures to fund advisory services and training for Districts.

Mrs. Missildine also reported that the Examiner's Office had reworked the Annual ECD Reporting Form which is due on November 30 each year. She stated the new form had been circulated to all the Districts with a reminder for completion.

Mrs. Missildine then presented the Board with an update on the Blount County/Leeds Consolidation. She then asked Mr. Neal Brooks, Blount County Interim 9-1-1 Director, to share an overview of the project.

Mr. Brooks presented a timeline of work that was required to have a successful consolidation. He stated he would suggest an 18-month planning period for anyone who might be interested in consolidation. He explained the process of collaboration between vendors and service providers and how the transition occurred. Chief Charles Parsons, Leeds Fire Department, also addressed the Board and offered a positive review of the smooth transition and spoke to the improvements that are being felt immediately by his first responders and the citizens of Leeds. He offered several examples of improved safety, call times, and responsiveness from Communications. Mr. Scott Barnett, General Counsel for the City of Leeds, also spoke to express his satisfaction in the transition and echoed the remarks of Mr. Brooks and Chief Parsons.

Mrs. Missildine discussed the Federal Grant funding program and reported that we are waiting for the funding allocation and application to be published.

Mrs. Missildine then presented the Board with a summary of Grant Cycle 4 and explained the process of evaluation for each project and the prioritization of project types. She reported there



were 17 projects for a total request of \$2,251,765.74. She also reported that 7 Districts requested stand-alone CPE, which totaled nearly \$1.5 million. The Board staff consulted the proposing vendor and asked for alternative options. The vendor offered a hosted CPE solution to the Districts and met with those Grant Cycle applicants to assess interest.

Mrs. Missildine made the recommendation to the Board to award \$581,190.00 to 6 Districts for a hosted next-generation CPE solution.

Mr. Wayne Hutchens made a motion to approve Grant Cycle 4 Award for a hosted CPE not to exceed \$581,190.00; seconded by Mr. Alan Campbell. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried. Mrs. Melissa Dove abstained from voting.

Mrs. Missildine continued with Grant Cycle Awards for the remaining projects requested which total \$267,151.32 and made the recommendation to the Board to approve the awarding of these funds to complete Grant Cycle 4.

Mr. Alan Campbell made a motion to approve the remaining Grant Cycle 4 Awards; seconded by Mr. Robert Smith. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried. Mrs. Melissa Dove abstained from voting.

Mrs. Missildine presented a progress report on the Alabama EMD Program offering statistics of participation throughout the program and training. She summarized EMD coverage in Alabama and explained that based on agency-reported data at least 92% of Alabama's population is receiving EMD service today.

Mrs. Missildine advised the Board that she is still receiving quotes from different agencies for worker's compensation insurance.

She also advised the Board that the legal services contract is due for an RFP which will be released in December, proposals will be reviewed at the January 2019 Board meeting. She made a recommendation to the Board to authorize the staff to release an RFP for legal services for the calendar year 2019.

Mr. Alan Campbell made the motion to authorize staff to release an RFP for legal services; Mr. Wayne Hutchens seconded. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.

Mrs. Missildine also advised the Board that the professional consulting services contract with 911 Authority is due to be renewed. She made a recommendation to the Board to continue the contract with 911 Authority for the next two years.

Mrs. Melissa Dove made the motion to continue the contract with 911 Authority; Mr. Robert Smith seconded. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.

Mrs. Missildine continued her report with a discussion about Cost Recovery. She reported that we are currently accepting Cost Recovery plans which are due November 30, 2018. Those plans will be reviewed and presented for approval at the January 2019 Board meeting. She also made a



recommendation to the Board to declare \$2 million excess in Cost Recovery funds to be distributed back to the Districts.

Mr. Wayne Hutchens made a motion to declare \$2 million excess Cost Recovery funds to be distributed back to the Districts; Mrs. Melissa Dove seconded. There were no objections; therefore, the motion was carried.
