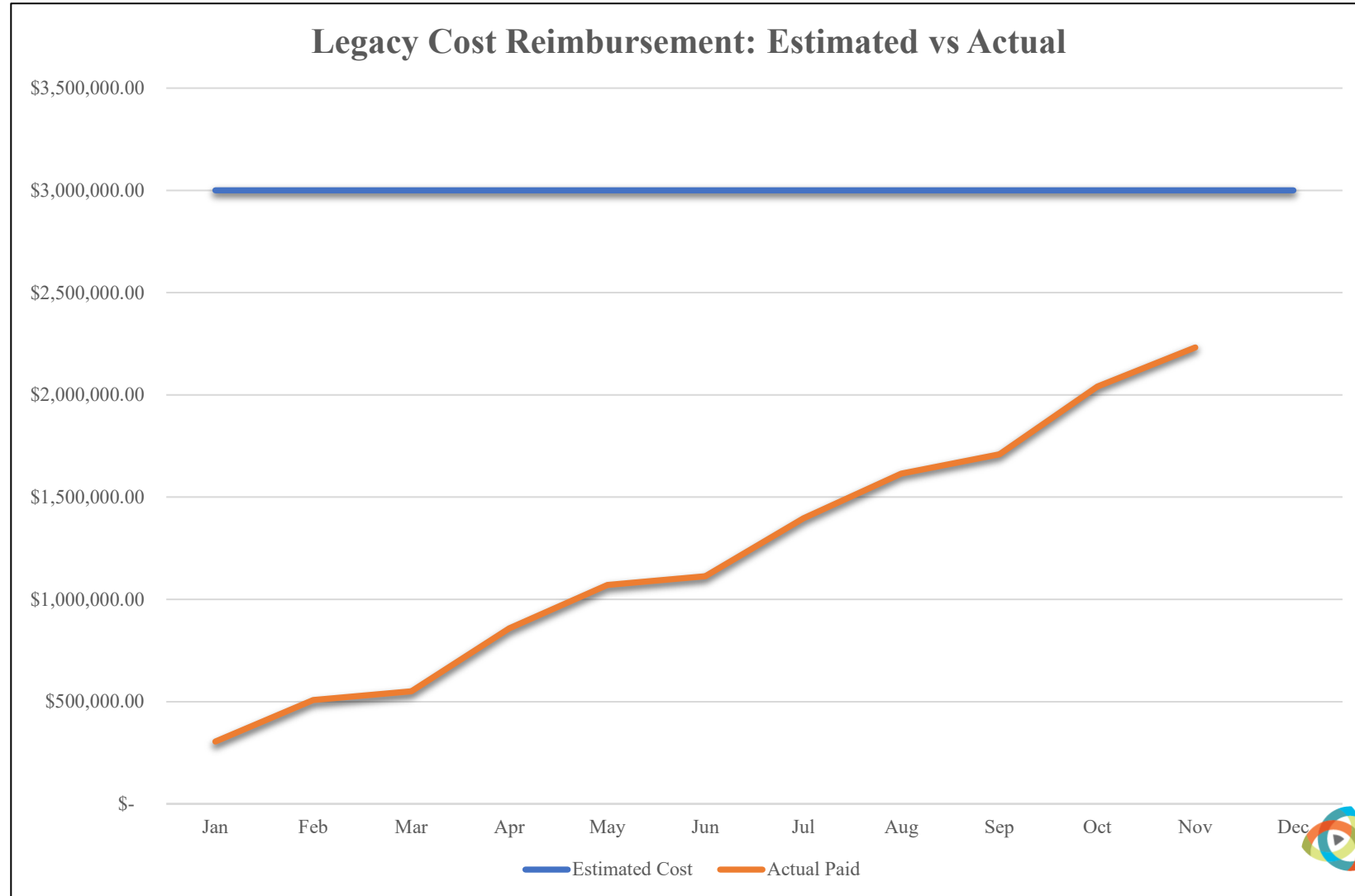

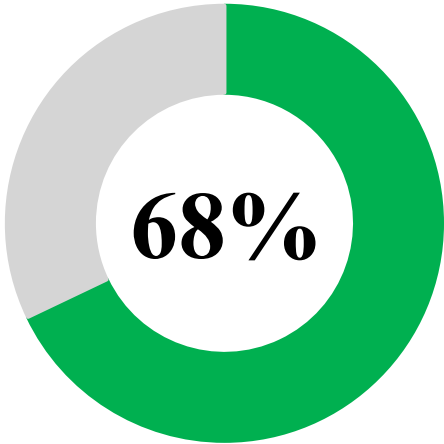

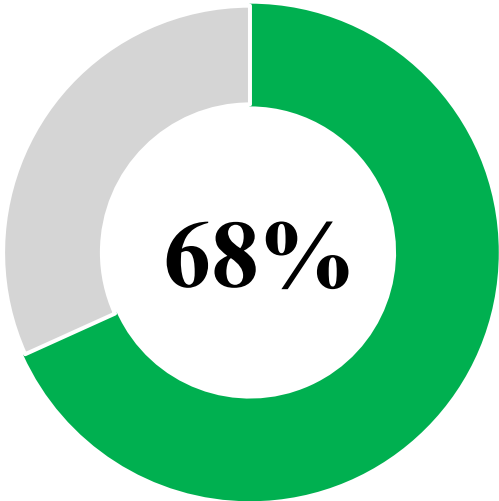

- Number of Districts Not Participating = 27

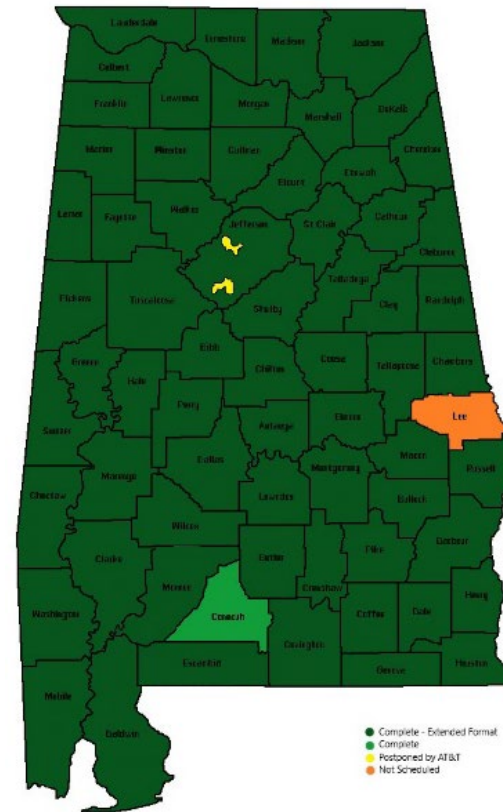


AT&T ALI Disconnection Process & Progress
