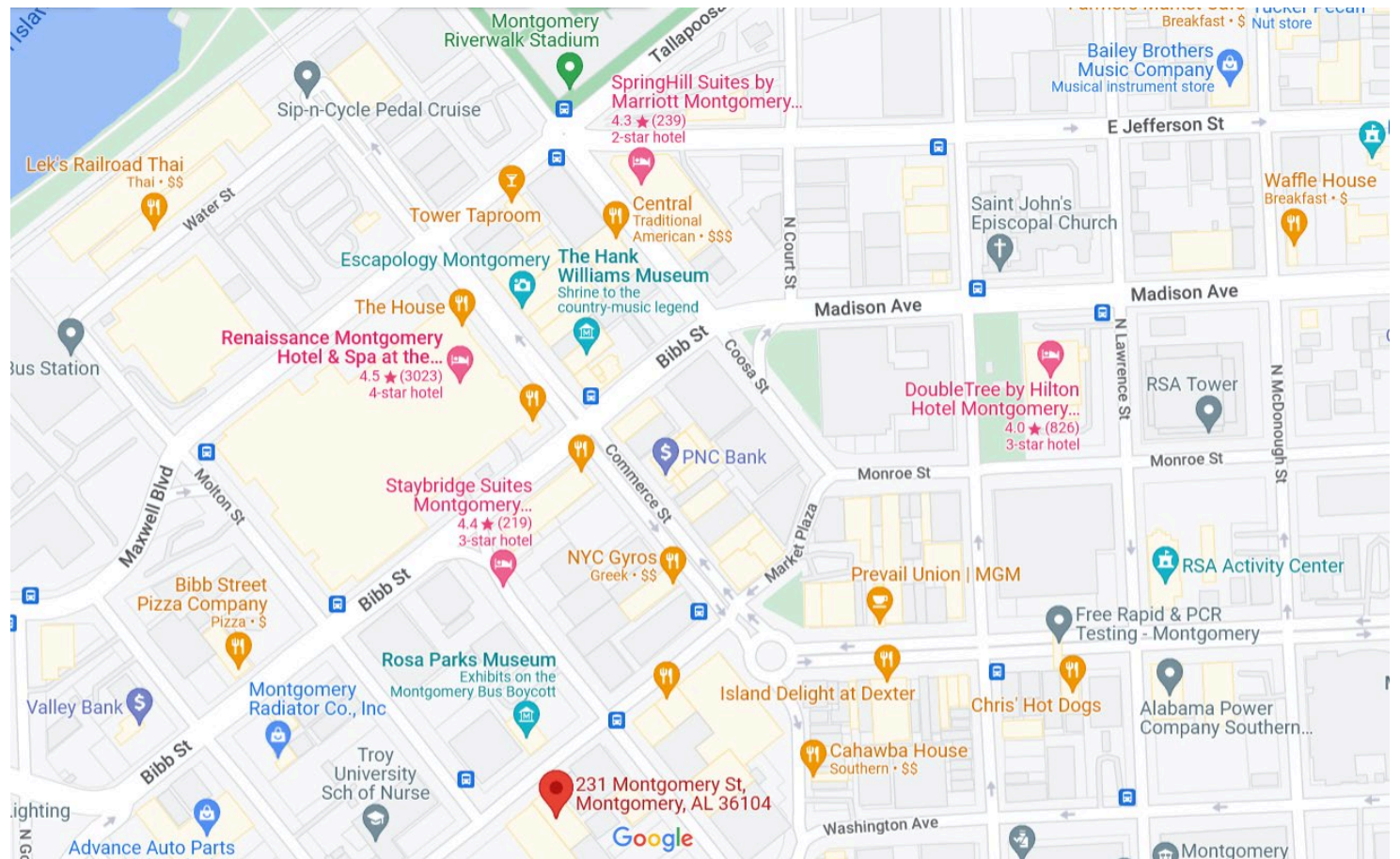

OTM Cyber will host the first annual OTM Cyber WarGames training event for Alabama 911! The event will be held on April 14th, 2022 at Troy University, 231 Montgomery Street, Gold Room in Montgomery. The event will last from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm with lunch provided.

The OTM Cyber WarGames will be an in-person live action role play of various cyber events. Attendance is free for 911 agencies and their teams. It will be a daylong event. The scenarios will be based on real-life cyber incidents faced by 911 agencies across the country. This does not require an in-depth technical background or understanding.
