Alabama 9-1-1 Board Grant Program | Cycle 7

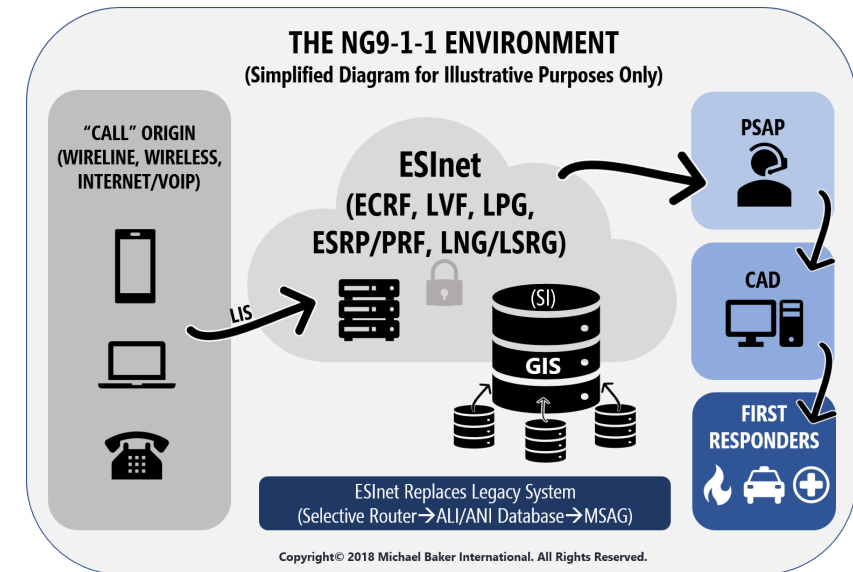
Goal & Purpose

- The goal of the Alabama 9-1-1 Board Grant Program is to provide financial assistance to Emergency Communication Districts (ECDs) based on demonstrated need(s) in compliance with §11-98 et seq. of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended. The purpose is to fund non-recurring costs necessary to achieve or maintain continuity and enhancement of 9-1-1, assuring that every location in Alabama has access to 9-1-1 service.
- The grant program will be funded to the extent that funds are available to the Alabama 9-1-1 Board in compliance with §11-98 et seq. of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended and the administrative rules of the Alabama 9-1-1 Board.



Alabama 9-1-1 Board Grant Program | Cycle 7

- The two main type of projects that Grant Cycle 7 is focused on are:
 - The elimination of legacy connections via gateways and legacy call handling equipment that remain in the ANGEN System
 - GIS related projects that assist in the completion of the Board's NG9-1-1 GIS Project



Alabama 9-1-1 Board Grant Program | Cycle 7

ELIGIBILITY

- Validly formed Alabama ECD
- In compliance with §11-98 et seq. of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended
- Willing to provide reasonable data at request
- Submitted an ECD Certification for 2022
- Submitted annual self-reporting information required by the Examiners for FY2021

CALENDAR

May 31, 2022

- ✓ Grant Cycle 7 opened for application submission

August 1, 2022

- ECD grant applications postmarked or delivered to the Alabama 9-1-1 Board Office

August-September 2022

- Applications will be evaluated by the Alabama 9-1-1 Board

September 21, 2022

- Grant award recommendations will be presented during the Board meeting for action



Important Things to Remember

- Eligible use of grant funding should comply with §11-98-6, Code of Alabama, as amended
- Each submission should include **one original printed copy** and **one electronic copy**
- Procurement processes should follow both local ECD requirements and any applicable Alabama law
- All applications will require at least two complete competitive vendors quotes or reasoning why two were not provided
- Depending on fund availability, the Alabama 9-1-1 Board may choose to award a portion of the cost of submitted projects and the applicant must provide verification of their ability to fund to difference
- Those receiving grant awards will be required to submit quarterly Status Reports for the project, until its completion



Alabama 9-1-1 Board Grant Cycle 7 Application

Grant Cycle 7 Application

- All application form pages are fillable Word documents
- Completely fill out all pages of Appendix 11.1.2 of the Application Document
- Submissions should provide clear and sufficient detail of the proposed project
- The Evaluation Team will notify the applicant of any missing items within 30 days of submission
- Project Agreement, Request for Change Form and Status Report Form are provided for reference
