2022

- May 18, 2022—adoption of the draft rule and approval to proceed with the rules process at the Alabama 9-1-1 Board Meeting
- May 20, 2022—deadline for submission of the Notice of Intended Action for proposed rule making

June/  
July  
2022

- June/July 2022—receive comments on the proposed draft rule; tentatively plan a workshop for discussion of the rule
- July 27, 2022—hold a public hearing prior to the July Board meeting; final adoption of the rule will be recommended during the meeting

August  
2022

- August 11, 2022—certification of the final adopted rule must occur no later than this date

October  
2022

- October 15, 2022—certified rule will take effect

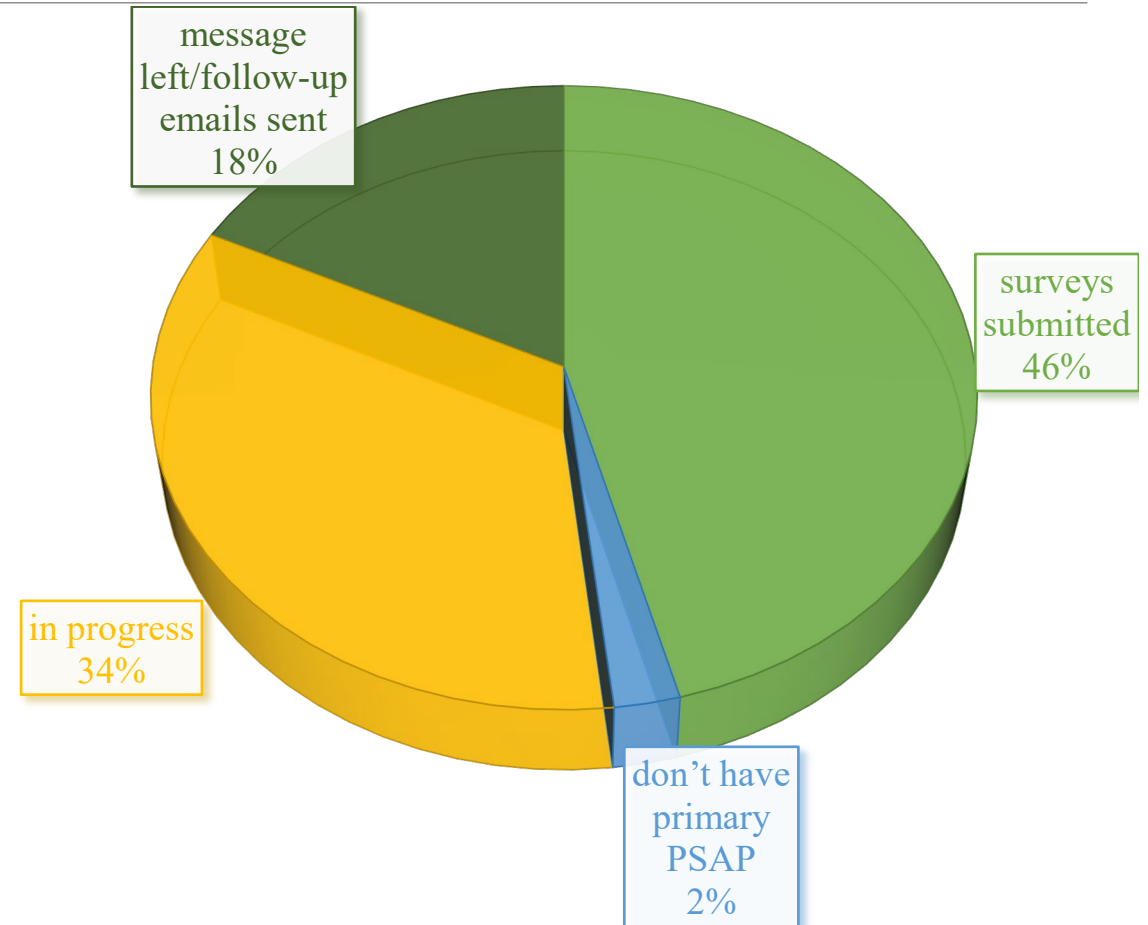

# ECD Template

➤ **Of our 85 ECDs:**

- 15 ECDs have been left messages and follow-up emails

# PST Surveys

- **715 telecommunicator surveys submitted**
- **59 primary PSAPs represented in those submissions**
- **Helpful Hints:**
  - Specify which basic PST training course you successfully completed, e.g. APCO, NENA, AL Fire College, In-house, HITS, etc.
  - If you specify you completed a basic PST training course, check yes you completed a PST certification program
  - Upload your most current basic PST certificate. That may be your renewal certificate
  - If you do not have your certificate to upload, please contact the organization that certified you for a copy

- 2) Do I have to fire my PSTs that are not certified?
  - No
- 3) How will we get my PSTs certified in Virtual Academy?
  - We do not have a certification class in VA yet, but we may in the future
- 4) Why do we require a middle name?
  - So, when we have three John Smith's, we can tell them apart.
- 5) Why do we have to fill out the spreadsheet and individual surveys?
  - It's a check and balance to verify we received all the telecommunicator information.

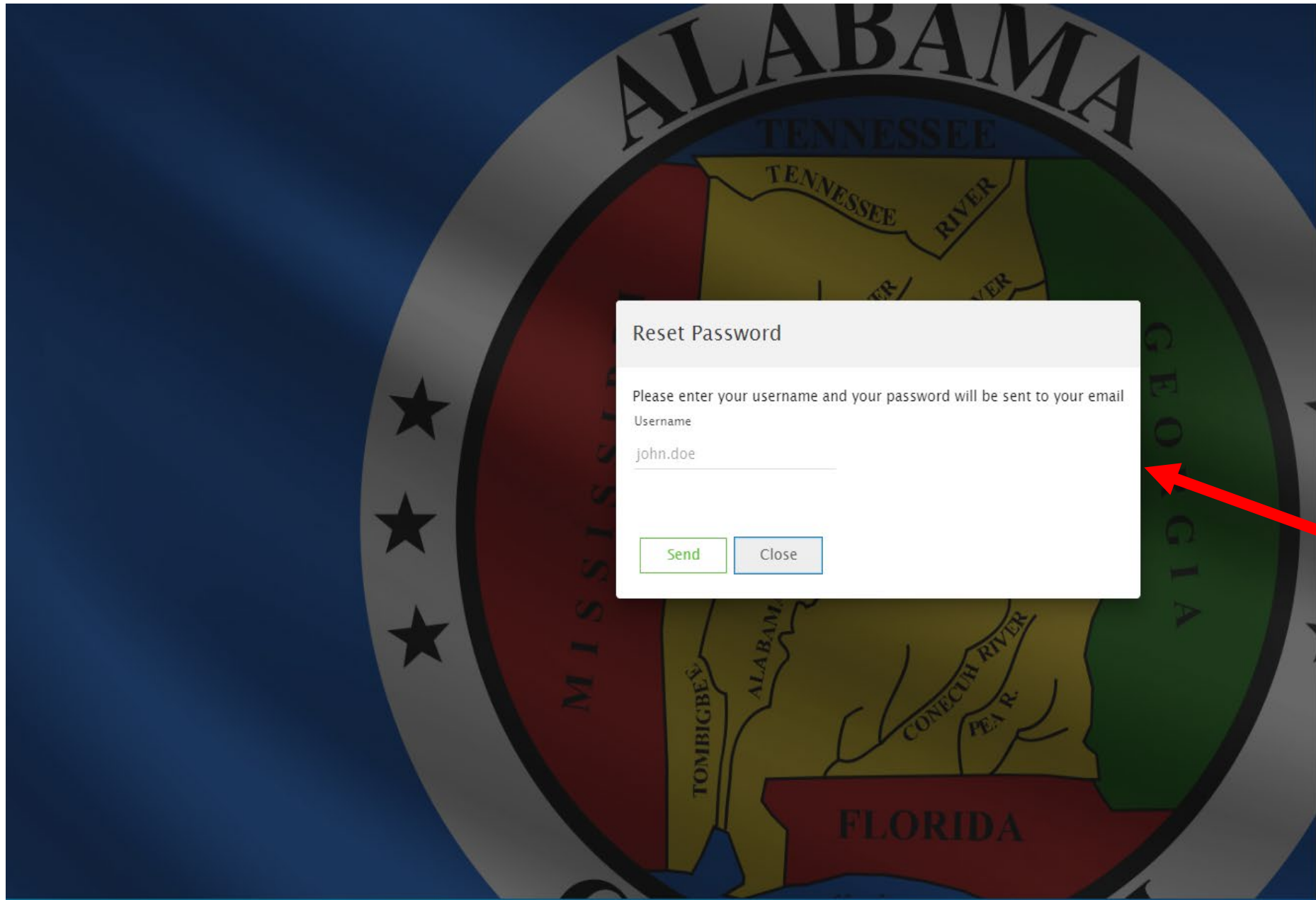
