

988 | The Suicide & Crisis Lifeline

- > 988 was officially designated by Federal law in October 2020 as the single number to dial for mental health crisis and suicide prevention
 - > Allows states to establish a subscriber fee designated for 9-8-8
 - > Enables funding of other mental health services such as mobile crisis teams
- > 988 is the evolution of the National Suicide Prevention Hotline, (800) 273-TALK
- > Grant for initial implementation costs offered by a division of HHS
- > Carriers were required to direct calls to the Lifeline using 988 by July 16, 2022.















988 in Alabama

- ➤ Alabama Department of Mental Health awarded grant funding for 988 implementation and longrange planning in March 2021
- > State Legislature established the 988 Study Commission in April 2021 to consider eight main criteria outlined in the grant request for application
 - o 988 Coalition assembled to supply report to the Study Commission by August 2021
 - Stakeholders include those from mental health, crisis centers, academia, and 9-1-1
 - Coalition evaluated current call volumes, staffing, and funding; expansion needs for 24/7 availability; developed a framework for public awareness; and drafted an implementation plan for the state

988 Study Commission Report

Released to the Legislature on January 5, 2022 with two recommendations:

- o For a Joint Resolution to be passed continuing the operation of the 988 **Study Commission**
- Additional revenue-generating considerations during the 2023 Legislative Session based on actual call volume and supporting data




988 Crisis Call Centers in Alabama

Ongoing 988 Initiatives

➤ NENA Working Group

- o 911/988 Interactions Standard
- o Goal is to provide guidance to 911 Centers on best practice for handling mental health crisis calls and how to best interoperate with local 988 call centers
- o Standards document that will be produced will differ slightly from the existing Suicide/Crisis Line Interoperability Standard (NENA-STA-001.2-2022)



- Continued work with Alabama Department of Mental Health
 - o Alabama 9-1-1 Board staff will continue to participate in the 988 Coalition
 - o Participation in a focus group to assist ADMH and their contractor in strategic plan formulation
 - o Provide any technical, operational, and training input to ensure smooth interoperability of the state's crisis call centers and 9-1-1 centers




