Legacy Cost Reimbursement: Estimated vs Actual




Legacy Cost Reimbursement: Year to Year








Virtual Academy Hours by District January 1 - February 28, 2023


Lumen Circuit Replacement as of March 1, 2023






ESiNet Trends

The busiest day during the reporting period was January 1st – 14,551 calls were processed. The second busiest day was February 25th – 13,330 calls were processed.

The average call volume per day was 12,028 which is up from 11,866 the previous reporting period – total calls since last report was 709,650.








Friday proved to have the heaviest call volume Sunday showing the least



ANGEN Total Call Count February 12, 2018 - February 28, 2023







Next Steps - Geo Routing Alabama Region 1 Data

- Current, transitional phase geo-routing is in place for Jefferson County and PSAPs within.
- Region 1 data was received by INdigital at the end of February.
- The data has been checked for topology and geometry errors and will be merged with current shapefiles; updating previous boundaries and adding new boundaries.
- After QA, the data will be put into production and coordinated for testing, dates to be announced.






Region 1 Boundary Facilitation Meeting Participation


