


Showers Late




Scattered Thunderstorms

Rain showers in the morning with scattered thunderstorms arriving in the afternoon. High 76F. Winds S at 10 to 15 mph. Chance of rain 50%.


Variable clouds with scattered thunderstorms. Low 61F. Winds light and variable. Chance of rain 50%.
