Language Translation Services Open Enrollment ends August 31

- > Open enrollment for language translation services offered by the Board with Voiance will run August 1 through August 31. This is only for those primary PSAPs that are not already enrolled in the language translation services (Voiance) offered by the Board.
- ➤ Why Voiance? Because it is already recognized by state Purchasing under NASPO ValuePoint Master Service Agreement 90-000-18-00003AG.
- **Process:** Fill out the <u>form</u>. It is reviewed by Board staff. Then, Andi Murphree with INdigital will coordinate with your PSAP and Voiance to get it implemented.












Board Announcements & Reminders

- Request for Payment for PST Certification Submissions made by the 10th will be paid out at the end of the month. Anything submitted after the 10th will be paid at the end of the following month.
- ➤ Upload, validate, aggregate your GIS data to the State office VEP.
