The Current and Future Uses of GIS in Alabama 9-1-1



Current

Only PSAP boundaries are being used to route wireless calls.



Current

The location information used to route is obtained with a database dip.



Current

GIS data is handed off between the board and INdigital.



Future

All required layers can be utilized during any call routing.



Future

Location information will come with the call (PIDF-LO).



Future

GIS data will be passed via a spatial interface, where it will be stored and will then provision the other functional elements.



PSAP Boundary

Operational boundaries that determine what 9-1-1 calls are routed to a PSAP to be answered in an NG91-1 i3 environment. PSAP boundaries answer the question “who gets the 91-1 call.” Boundaries cannot have gaps or overlap, as these would result in a 9-1-1 call not being routed most efficiently.

Provisioning Boundary

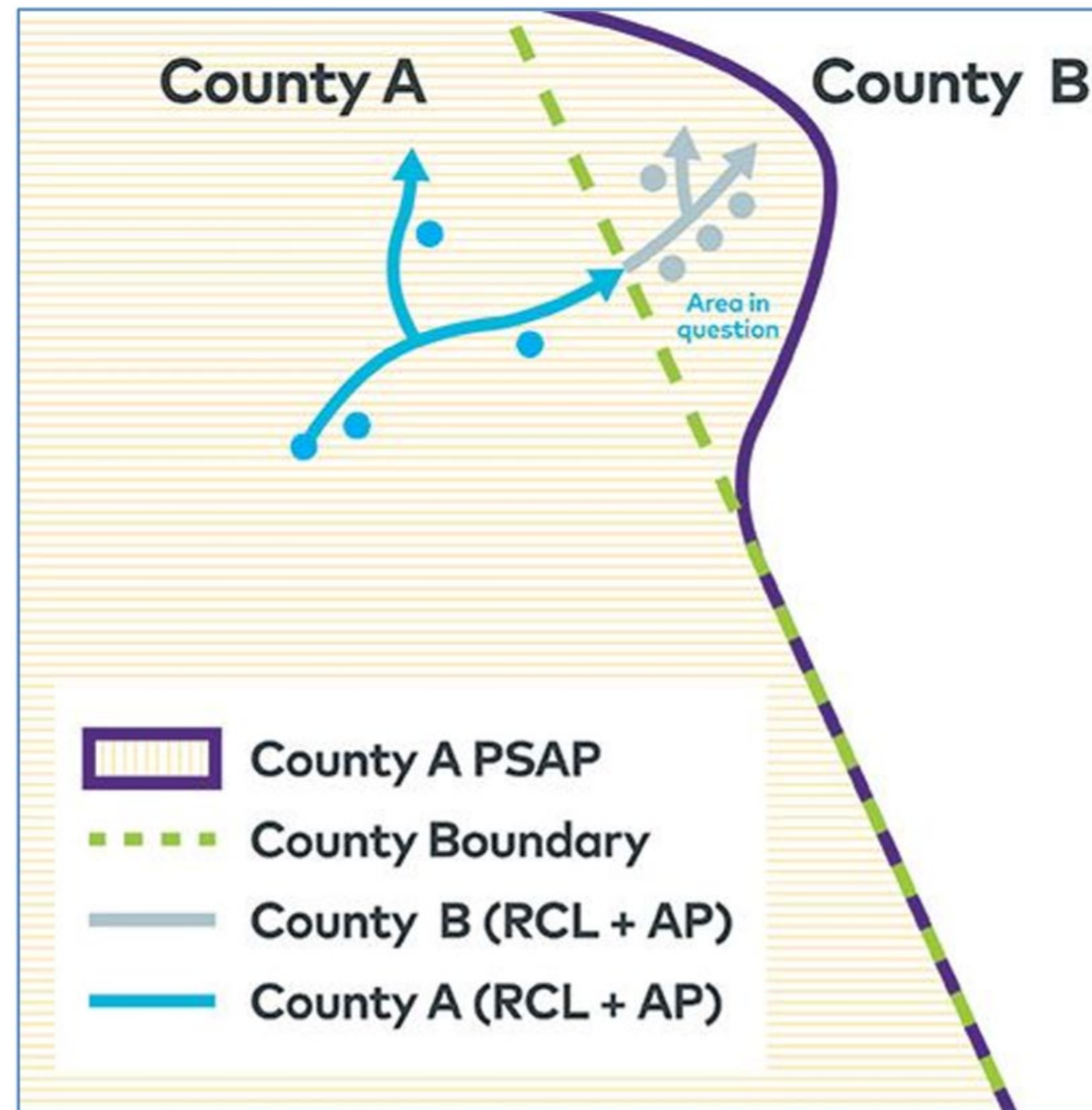
Boundaries that identify the area of responsibility for a GIS data provider for a NG9-1-1 system. NG9-1-1 needs all features in the required GIS layers submitted once and only once with no gaps, overlaps, or duplicates.

Emergency Service Boundaries (ESB)

Law, Fire, and EMS. NG9-1-1 requires separate ESB layers to show the agency with the primary responsibility for each type of emergency response but can be more detailed. In NG9-1-1, the information is used beyond a PSAP for call transfers and documentation.

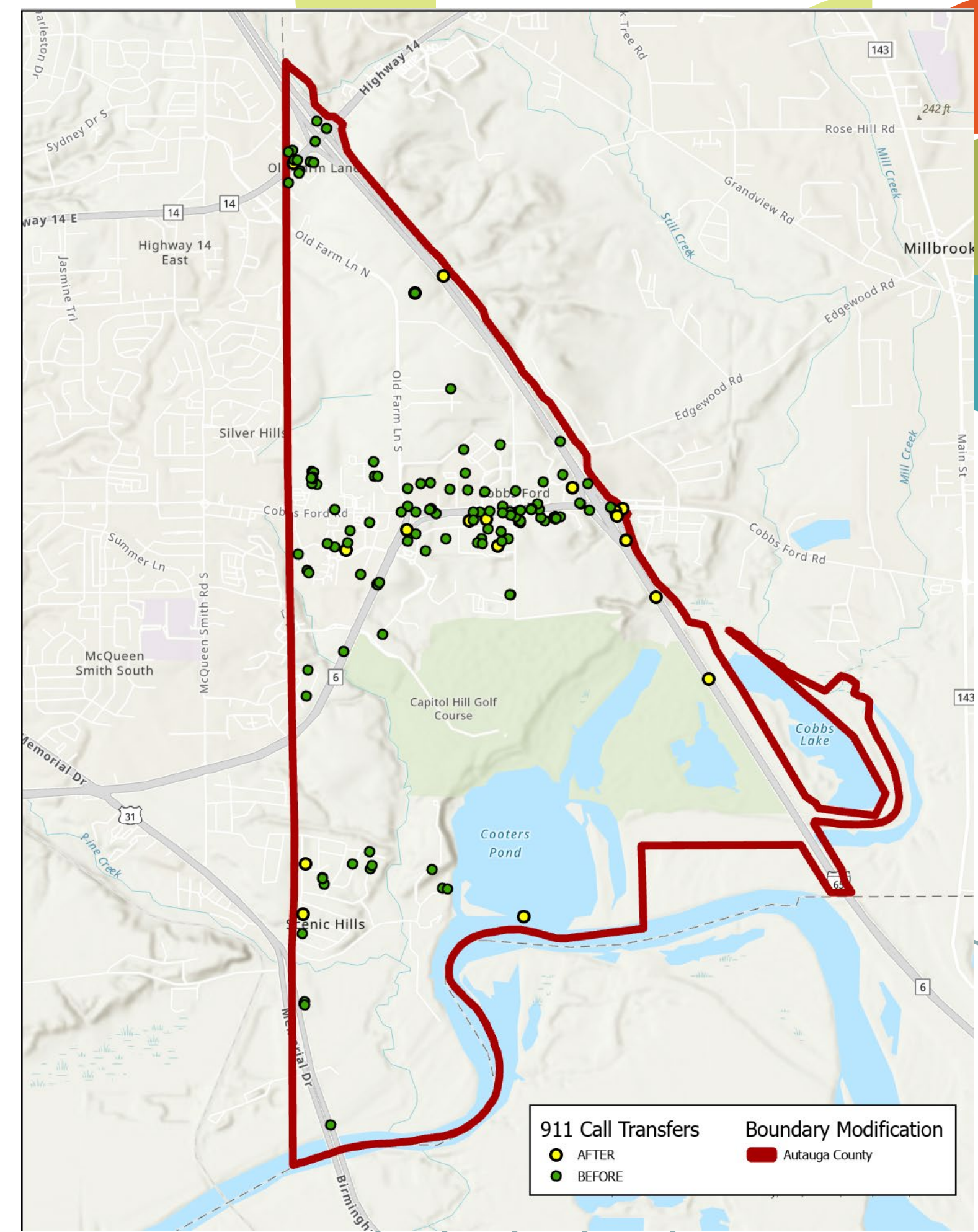
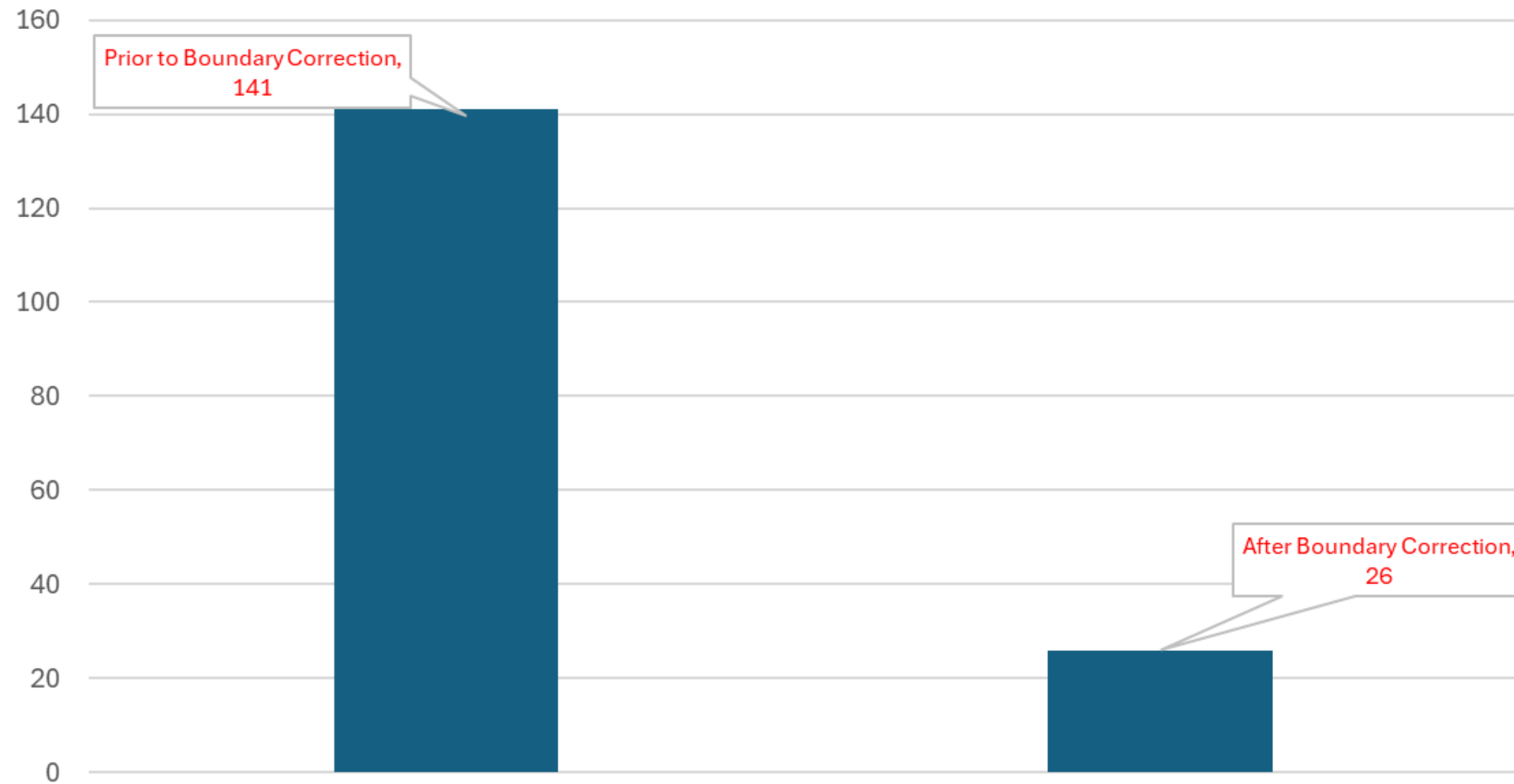


There are some cases where ECDs may decide to have provisioning and PSAP boundaries that are not coincident. In these cases, localities will be dependent on each other to upload data (e.g., PSAP boundary, address points, road centerlines) that others require. Once the data is in the Spatial Interface, anyone can utilize it.

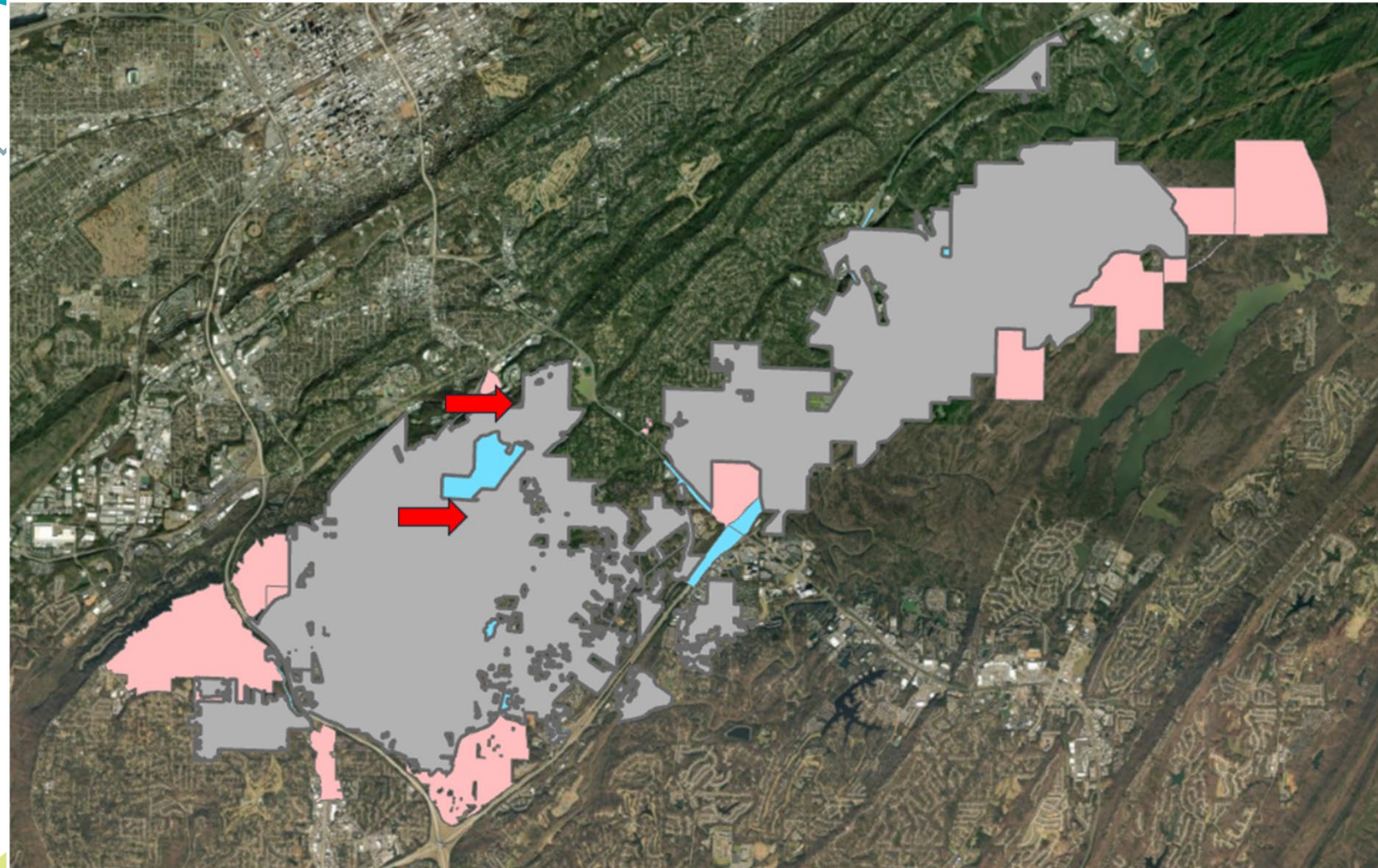




Elmore to Autauga Transfers 3 week comparison Prior To and After Boundary Correction

The Gray area is the PSAP boundary. The pink (fire) and blue (law) service areas outside their PSAP boundary.

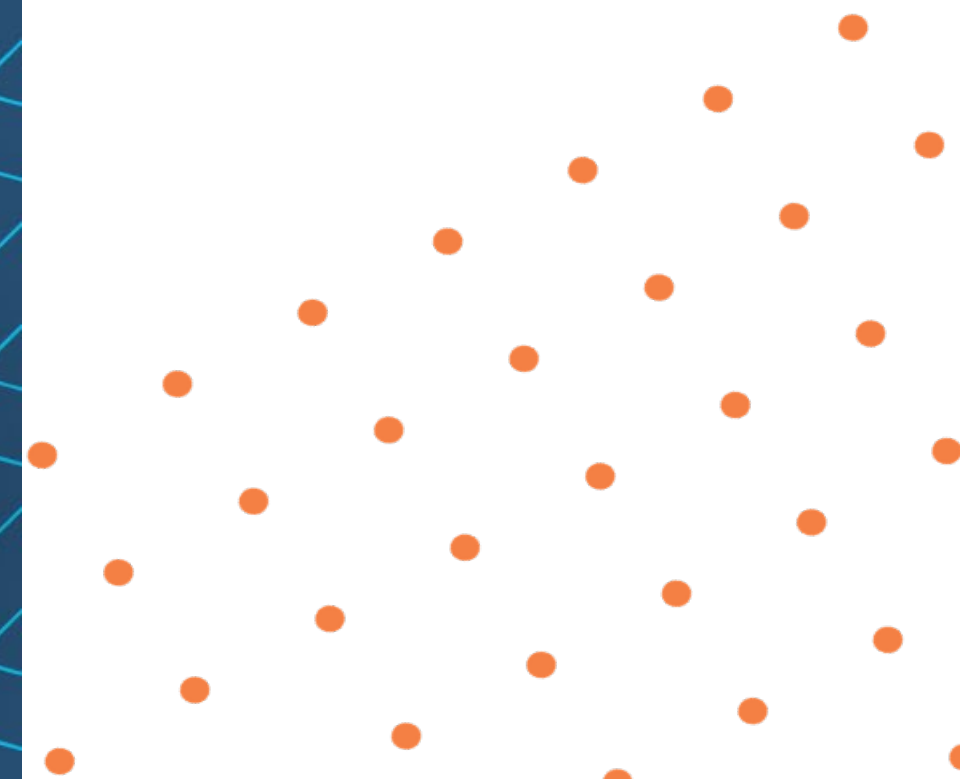
